

## **Short Certificate - Medical Assisting**

The medical assisting certificate program requires the student to complete 25 semester hours, 24 of which are in medical assisting courses. This program will prepare students for careers in the health care field by offering courses in both the clinical and administrative functions of a physician's office. Prior to completion of the medical assisting certificate, students will complete a 225-hour preceptorship in a medical setting.
