

# Student Cares Act Report

## Updated December 22, 2021

### Overview

Chattahoochee Valley Community College has established an emergency financial aid grant to assist students through federal funds provided under America Rescue Plan (ARP/HEERF) of the CARES Act. The ARP, which establishes and provide funds to assist students in defraying educational expenses associated with COVID-19.

**Funds Received.** CVCC received **\$2,870,735** from the Department pursuant to the ARP Grant Student Portion.

**Funds Distributed.** The College distributed 20 percent of the ARP Grant on in the amount of **\$1,127,442** during the Fall 2021 Semester.

**Eligible Participants.** CVCC awarded all Fall Semester 2021 students who were legitimately and currently enrolled in credit. A small percentage of students also received a \$50 incentive payout based on vaccination status.

**Students Receiving Funds:** Approximately **1,354** students received CARES Act funds from the College, totaling \$1,127,442.

**Method for Determining Eligible Students and Amount of Award.** CVCC awarded all Fall Semester 2021 students who were legitimately and currently enrolled in credit courses. Non-credit students and students who have withdrawn from the College were not be considered.
