ONLINE CLASSES

- Students enrolling in online classes must meet the following criteria:
 - \circ $\,$ View and complete a required orientation session and assignment online for:
 - * Pirate 13 (1A), Term I (2A) and Full Semester
 - By midnight on Friday, January 14, 2022
 - Pirate 13 (1B)
 - By midnight on Friday, February 4, 2022
 - * Term II
 - By midnight on Tuesday, March 8, 2022
 - Students who do not view the orientation session and complete the assignment by this date will be dropped from the class.
 - If you are dropped from the class for not completing the assignment, your instructor may notify you. If this happens you may request reinstatement. To do so, please complete the Reinstatement form found at <u>http://www.cv.edu/student-forms/</u>.
 - You may have 5 days or less to request reinstatement from the day you have been dropped.
 - Students may not be allowed to enroll in online classes unless the pre-requisites for the classes have been satisfied.
 - One major exam or assignment for online classes must be proctored. Available dates and instructions for the exam/assignment are posted in your Blackboard class and/or syllabus.
 - For fully online classes there is a requirement to offer students one major exam in a
 proctored setting. There will be no charge to students for this service. Students will need to
 use a computer or laptop (with webcam). More details to follow.

HYBRID CLASSES

- Hybrid classes are a blend of online, computer-based learning and traditional face-to-face classroom instruction.
 - Hybrid classes require attendance on campus and via the Internet using Blackboard (has a phone app), online lecture videos, Collaborate (phone app available) or other instructional media.
- Please check your schedule for the day and time you meet on campus as well as the day and time you meet online. For the online meeting of some hybrid classes, you will log in to meet virtually with your instructor and classmates.
 - If no day and time is listed next to your online listing, you do not meet virtually at an appointed day and time. Be sure to check your Blackboard and email consistently for updates and assignments.
