Chattahoochee Valley Community College's A.A.S. and certificate in EMS programs include Emergency Medical Technician Short Certificate, Advanced Emergency Medical Technician Short Certificate, Emergency Medical Services Paramedic Certificate, and Associate of Applied Science in Emergency Medical Services Paramedic. The program is to prepare students with the foundational knowledge and skills necessary to become professional EMS Clinicians, at their respective level. Upon successful completion of certificate or degree in the EMS program, the graduates are eligible to sit for the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technician (NREMT) Certification Exam. It is the responsibility of the student to satisfy the licensure requirements for each State in which the individual wishes to hold a license in, as each State sets their own requirements.
