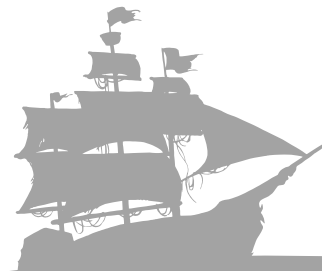

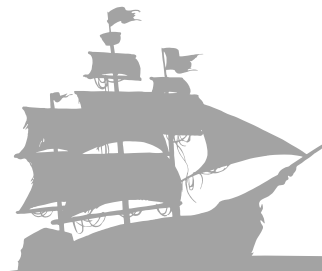
When Registering:
